# Nausea & Vomiting

- Lorazepam 1 mg/mL/Diphenhydramine HCl 12.5 mg/mL/Haloperidol 2 mg/mL/Metoclopramide HCl 20 mg/mL Topical gel (Also known as ABHR.)
- Ondansetron 4 mg/0.1 mL Topical gel
- Ondansetron 8 mg Oral Effervescent
- Ondansetron 8 mg Base MBK (Blue Mold) Suppository
- Promethazine HCl 25 mg/mL Topical gel
- Lorazepam 1 mg/Diphenhydramine HCl 12.5 mg/Haloperidol 2 mg Base MBK (Blue Mold) Suppository

#### Dry Mouth

- Sodium Cl 8.8 mg/Potassium Cl 3.1 mg/Calcium Cl 3.4 mg Base A Troche (Also referred to as a saliva stimulant troche or electrolyte troche.)
- Pilocarpine HCl 2 mg Base A Troche
- Saline/Glycerin Oral Suspension (Saliva substitute)
- Pilocarpine 10 mg/ml Oral Spray

# Excessive Secretions

• Glycopyrrolate 0.1 mg/0.25 ml gel

#### Odor

- Odor Masking (Sub Nasal) Balm (Many illnesses lead to unpleasant smells. Caregivers can apply this beneath thenostrils to mask a smell.)
- No Rinse Shampoo/Body Wash
- Chlorophyll Ointment (Sometimes tumors or wounds may smell. Chlorophyll can help neutralize odors.)
- Chlorophyllin 0.2% Mouthwash (Illnesses sometimes cause halitosis.)
- Camphor 12%/Menthol 2%/Methyl Salicylate 5% Nasal Ointment

# Wound Care

# Treatment of Wounds Without Infection:

- Phenytoin 5%/Misoprostol 0.0024% Topical Gel
- Phenytoin 2%/Misoprostol 0.0024%/Lidocaine 2%/Bupivacaine HCl 0.2%/Diphenhydramine HCl 1%/Aloe Vera 0.2% Polyox Bandage (The polyox bandage is a good base for oozing wounds.)
- Ketoprofen 2%/Lidocaine 2%/Misoprostol 0.0024%/Phenytoin 2%/Aloe Vera 0.2% Topical Cream

# Treatment of Infected Wounds:

- Misoprostol 0.0024%/Phenytoin 5%/Metronidazole 2% Topical Gel
- Misoprostol 0.0024%/Phenytoin 5%/Gentamicin 0.2% Topical Gel

# Treatment of Wounds with Pain:

 Morphine Sulfate 1 mg/mL Topical Gel (Topical morphine is an option for wound pain and is usually requested after someone has had minimal success with lidocaine.)

# Pain

- Ketamine 10%/Gabapentin 6%/Clonidine 0.2%/Nifedipine 2% Topical gel
- Morphine Sulfate 5% Topical gel
- Fentanyl 100 mcg/0.1 mL Topical gel
- Ibuprofen Suppository
- Ketoprofen 10% Topical gel
- Hydrocodone/APAP Suppository
- Oxycodone Hydrochloride 30 mg Base MBK (Blue Mold) Suppository
- Morphine Sulfate 50 mg Base F (Medium Shell Mold)
- Lidocaine HCl 4% Isotonic Nasal Spray
- Ibuprofen 20% in Transdermal Gel
- Belladonna Extract 15 mg/Morphine Sulfate 7.5 mg Base MBK (Blue Mold) Suppository (B&O Suppositories are no longer commercially available.)
- Fentanyl 50 mcg/mL Nasal Spray
- Hydrocodone Bitartrate 20 mg SR Capsules Size #1

#### Mouth Pain

- Misoprostol 0.0024%/Diphenhydramine HCl 0.1%/Compound Oral Rinse (Often referred to as radiation burn mouth rinse.)
- Morphine Sulfate 1 mg/mL Oral Gel
- Glutamine Mouthwash 2 Gm/5 mL
- Glutamine 250 mg Polyglycol Troche™ Base Lollipop
- Misoprostol 0.0024%/Lidocaine HCl 1% Oral Suspension

# Burning Mouth Syndrome

Salicylic Acid 0.3% Mouthwash (Also referred to as BMS mouthwash.)

#### Oral Thrush

- Clotrimazole 80 mg/Lidocaine HCl 0.5% Sorbitol Lollipop™ Base
- Amphotericin 100 mg Gelatin Troche
- Amphotericin B 500 mg Sorbitol LollipopτM Base
- Nystatin 100,000 u/mL Oral Suspension (SF)

# Radiation Burns

- Ketoprofen 2%/Lidocaine 2%/Misoprostol 0.0024%/Phenytoin 2%/Aloe Vera 0.2% Topical Cream (Often referred to as radiation burn cream.)
- Radiation Therapy Lotion
- Aloe Vera/Vitamin E/Collagen/Allantoin/Lanolin Topical Cream
- Aloe Vera/Vitamin E/Collagen/Allantoin/Lanolin Topical Lotion
- Misoprostol 0.0024%/Diphenhydramine HCl 0.1%/Compound Oral Rinse (Often referred to as radiation burn mouth rinse.)

### Constipation

Naltrexone 0.5 mg Capsules Size #3 (Opioid-induced)
